**STEM -STUDENTS EXPANDING POSSIBILITIES UNDERGRADUATE Program
(STEP-UP)**

Science, Technology, Engineering & Math Students

The S-STEM program for the 2009-2010 academic year is now accepting applications. This program, funded by the National Science Foundation, provides up to \$5,000 per year for up to two years in scholarship support for academically talented and financially needy SJC students pursuing a degree in one of the following targeted fields:

- Aeronautical Technology
- Biological sciences (except medicine and other clinical fields)
- Computer Electronics Technology
- Computer Science, Computer Engineering, or Computer Information Technology
- Engineering or Engineering Design Graphics
- Geographic Information Science
- Mathematics
- Non-Destructive Technology
- Physical sciences, including physics, chemistry, and materials science
- Process Technology

Requirements and Eligibility

In order to be considered for a scholarship, candidates:

- **must be United States citizens, permanent residents, nationals, or refugees**
- **must have a GPA of 2.5 or better** on all college level work; 3.0 GPA if coming from high school
- **must be enrolled as a full time student** (minimum of 12 credits per semester) in one of the targeted fields
- **must demonstrate academic potential**
- **must have a documented financial need** (based on a completed **FAFSA** application)

Fall 2009 Application Deadline: August 28, 2009. Awardees will be notified during the month of September.
